## **Manitoba Housing Market Update**

December 2024



Manitoba's 2024 sales increased 11.4% over 2023 to 15,762, marking the third best year on record behind 2020 (16,789) and 2021 (19,672). The 2024 sales price increased 5.9% to \$369,297. The 2024 Sales-to-New-Listings ratio remained high at 69%. Months of inventory declined from 2.2 to 2.1 months.

Winnipeg had a 12.3% increase in sales in 2024 to 13,487; the average home price increased 6.1% to \$390,730. Winnipeg's 2024 Sale-to-New-Listings ratio was 70% indicating a year that continued to favour the sellers.

The unemployment rate increased 0.4 points to 6.2%. The largest industry monthly declines occurred in Construction (-3,000), Public Administration (-2,500), and Finance, Insurance, Real Estate and Leasing (-1,600). The largest industry monthly improvements were in Utilities(+900), Information, Culture and Recreation (+900), and Agriculture (+500). The monthly full-time employment decreased by 100 jobs, while the monthly part-time employment decreased by 7,000 jobs. Overall, employment decreased by 7,200 jobs for the month.
